# Program Transition Plan (As of 11/29/22)

#### **General Points:**

- UW-Milwaukee and UW-Oshkosh have elected to exercise the opt-out option defined in the current collaborative online AAS program MOU effective June 30, 2023.
- Transition planning will include representatives from UWEX, UW-Milwaukee, UW-Oshkosh, and all remaining partners with a focus on creating a
  seamless transition for impacted students. UWEX will provide regular updates to all affected parties as we proceed in the transition work
  defined below.
- Current degree-seeking students will have the ability to select their new home campus.
- A subgroup represented by the remaining AAS partners will conduct a review of all existing courses in the degree program to assess viability and make a determination regarding course continuation.
- Courses currently hosted by UW-Milwaukee and UW-Oshkosh defined for continuation in the course array will be distributed to the other program partners with a focus on and continued commitment to equity.
- UW-Milwaukee and UW-Oshkosh will satisfy all UW System and HLC reporting requirements for program suspension.
- UW-Milwaukee and UW-Oshkosh will continue to receive financial support as defined in the MOU addendum through FY22-23.

UW Extended Campus, in partnership with several other UW campuses including UW-Milwaukee, offers a Collaborative online AAS degree program. UW-Milwaukee will cease participation in this program effective July 1, 2023.

The vast majority of UWM students taking courses through this program are enrolled as "special students" and will be minimally impacted by UWM's departure. There are twelve students who are Collaborative AAS degree-seeking students. As we exit this program, the College of General Studies needs to ensure that these students have the information and support they need to complete the associate degree, if so desired.

To that end, the degree seeking students will receive a letter informing them that UWM will no longer be a partner in the degree program. They will be given the options of either 1) transferring to one of the five UW Institutions that will continue as a partner in the Collaborative AAS or 2) remaining with UWM and completing their AAS online through the College of General Studies.

Since the degree requirements for the Collaborative AAS and CGS AAS are indeed different, it may make sense for some to transition to another campus that is part of the Collaborative AAS based on their degree progress to date.

Students wanting to remain in the Collaborative will be connected to the Success Coaches at Extended Campus who will assist in helping the student transfer to a new home campus. Students who want to complete their associate degree at UWM (or are unsure about what to do) will meet with CGS advisors to figure out the next best steps. A "teach out" spreadsheet has been prepared by CGS Student Affairs to help advise students of their options.

UW Extended Campus, in partnership with several other UW campuses including UW-Milwaukee. offers an online AAS degree program. You are currently listed as degree-seeking student in this online AAS degree program. This letter is to inform you that at the end of the Spring 2023 semester, UW-Milwaukee will no longer be participating in the UW Extended Campus online AAS program. Starting in Fall 2023, UW-Milwaukee will be offering an online AAS program through the College of General Studies in Waukesha and Washington County.

If you would like to continue in the online AAS program offered by UW Extended Campus, you will need to select a new "home campus." There are five campuses to choose from — UW-Eau Claire, UW-Parkside, UW-River Falls, UW-Stevens Point, and UW-Whitewater. If you choose not to continue with the UW Extended Campus online AAS program, you can explore options (both face-to-face and online options) that will allow you to complete your AAS degree through the College of General Studies.

Whichever decision you make, support systems are in place to make this transition as seamless and easy as possible.
